## **Challenges**

**City** – Participating municipalities will compete against each other for a 1<sup>st</sup> Place prize in the form of a \$1,000 beautification grant.

- 2<sup>nd</sup> Place prize will be \$500
- 3<sup>rd</sup> Place will be \$250.

**Community** – One neighborhood association/organizations in the county will receive a \$500 beautification grant to be used in a public space in their community. Neighborhoods will still be encouraged to participate in Greenwood County's Great American Cleanup activities March - May.

- 2<sup>nd</sup> Place will receive \$250
- 3<sup>rd</sup> Place will receive \$100

**Collegiate** – College and university clubs are encouraged to organize cleanups around campus or adopt-a-spot in town. First place is \$500.

### **School Challenges –**

- **Recycled Art Challenge** – Individuals and classes create art projects made from recycled materials and compose a paragraph on the importance of recycling. Elementary, middle and high school ages are encouraged to participate.  
1<sup>st</sup> Place in each age group - \$250 rewarded to the art department for supplies.  
2<sup>nd</sup> Place in each age group - \$150 rewarded to the art department for supplies.
- **Cleanup Challenge** – Schools, classes or student clubs clean up litter on school grounds and surrounding areas. We ask that only middle and high school age groups participate in the cleanup challenge for obvious safety reasons. First place is \$250.
